

Blue Heron, Renaissance choir (Scott Metcalfe, director). **Blue Heron's 20th Birthday concert: Canterbury rediscovered.** Blue Heron's first concerts in October 1999 featured music from the Peterhouse partbooks (copied c. 1540 for Canterbury Cathedral) and the Peterhouse repertoire has been a mainstay of the ensemble's programs ever since. Blue Heron has released five CDs of the music and the fifth disc won the 2018 Gramophone Classical Music Award for Early Music. This 20th Birthday concert will feature favorite works by Aston, Ludford, and Sturmy from 20 years of Peterhouse programs.



It's a pleasure to look over the repertoire of music planned by Maestro Busby for the 2019-2020 choral season. It is rich from the Catholic and Anglican tradition ancient and modern. One particular pleasure this season will be the chanted Psalms using both Gregorian and Anglican chants. Mention of the Psalms makes us realize that music is not an addition to the liturgy; it is part and parcel of it, like marrow in the bones, and has been from the Song of Moses and Miriam at the shore of the Red Sea. Just to give one other but even more decisive example: When Jesus and his disciples were finished with the Last Supper (and the First Mass), before they went out, they sang a hymn. Sacred Music indeed.
